RULES

1. All bands are to report to the booking in point at Delph Library on Millgate (The Sound)
2. Bands must be signed in and ready to play when asked by officials
3. Final signing in time is 10.30pm
4. Final signing in time for Youth Bands is 9.00pm
5. Senior Officers reserve the right to regulate the number of bands entering after 10.00pm
6. All bands to play a street march from the starting point, stopping playing at the phone box
7. Bands must not perform with more than 25 players in the contest arena
8. Youth/School must not compete with more than 35 players, 4 of which may be adults
9. Conductors may conduct as many competing bands as they wish
10. The conductor is allowed to play but must count as one of the 25 players.
11. All contest marches played must be published.
12. The contest march is to be played once through with a DC to the Fine or Pause
13. Prizes will be awarded strictly according to the adjudicator's decision
14. Objections to be made to the Ring Secretary, together with a fee of £5.00 which will only be refunded if the objection is upheld
15. Only competing bands may make objections.
16. Registration cards are not necessary
17. No band is to win more than one prize with the exception of the Best Soloist/Section awards
18. Prizes monies are paid by cheque and forwarded within 7 days to the address given when signing in. Trophies are awarded at the Presentation Evening
19. Any outstanding Trophies are to be returned to the Contest Secretary or to Delph Band Club before contest day.
